No artistic experience is necessary during this self-exploration retreat in Italy at a thermal spa resort in a poet's historic villa in the heart of Tuscany. Only your curiosity and adventurous spirit is required. As members of the International Association for the Study of Dreams, Amy (a visual artist) and Tara (a songwriter and author) will guide you through the symbolic territory that dreams represent. Leonardo da Vinci dreamed humans could one day fly. His countless sketches led to that reality for all of us to experience today. This is why our dreams are so important. This is why we are going to explore the art of dreaming in Tuscany, all the while experiencing the best that Italy has to offer.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Stay at the 5-star luxury hotel Grotta Giusti Thermal Spa, a former 19th century villa of Italian poet Giuseppe Giusti in the heart of Tuscany. Experience the poetry of nature across the olive grove, herbal garden, caves, multiple pools and inspiring grounds.
- Take a dip in the largest natural thermal grotto in Europe. It is a breathtaking millenary cave, extending for over two hundred metres in the resort's subsoil. We will experience the healing power of a sound bath together in this extraordinary setting transporting us to a meditative state similar to dreaming.
- Visit Leonardo da Vinci's birthplace and museum where the artist-inventor dreamed his dreams that became a reality.
- Spend the day at Amy's private home, an oasis on an olive farm overlooking the rolling hills near the town of Barga. A private chef will cook for us as we engage in creative activities exploring dream work and sampling Amy's olive oil.
- Walk the streets of Florence at night with a local food expert who will teach us how to eat like a Tuscan.
- Attend a private rooftop party beside a pool overlooking the famous Duomo of Florence in our Plaza Hotel Lucchesi.
- Tour a local vineyard for a taste of the dreamy landscape.Discover the origin of tarot cards designed initially as a game in Tuscany in the 14th century. Learn how they are used today to interpret dream symbols.

Saturday, April 15 – Florence Arrival & Grotta Giusti Resort

Land at Florence International Airport in Italy. Upon arrival we will be greeted by our friendly and knowledgeable driver as we board our private coach bus. Once you hand over your suitcase, you won't carry it again for the entire journey. Get ready to be lifted and landed, wined and dined! Sunday, April 16 – Leonardo da Vinci Museum

After breakfast, Tara will conduct a dream workshop from 10am-Noon. Come prepared with a dream you would like to explore. Afterwards, we will hop on our small coach bus and head to lunch near the birthplace of Leonardo da Vinci one day after his April 15th birthday! Right in the heart of Vinci, in the Palazzina Uzielli and the Guidi Count's Castle, the Museo Leonardiano hosts the most ancient collection of models of Leonardo's works both as a scientist, technologist, and engineer. We will learn how the famous artist turned his dreams into creative masterpieces while overlooking a breath-taking landscape of the Montalbano hills which were a great inspiration for Leonardo. Return to our hotel for a sumptuous dinner.

Monday, April 17 - Olive Farm & w/ Private Chef & Vineyard Visit

After breakfast, we will drive at 10am to Amy's house about an hour away. The Chicago painter lives in the hillside in the enchanting Garfagnana valley of Tuscany between the Appennines and Apuane mountain ranges. The fog covered landscape inspires her art making each morning as she opens her shudders and listens to the trees singing across the rolling hills. Amy will conduct a creative dream workshop, and her private chef will make us a meal as we enjoy the views from her estate beside the pool. After tasting the olive oil from her own trees, we will walk down to her neighbor's vineyard for another tasting of his wine and cheese. **OVERNIGHT: GROTTA GIUSTI (B, L)**





Tuesday, April 18 – Sound Bath in the Grotto

After breakfast at our hotel, Tara will conduct a creative workshop from 10am-12pm on the grounds. Then at 4pm we will take a sound bath in the grotto caves of the hotel. In the warm embrace of the thermal steam, a Tibetan singing bowl concert leads us into a deep state of physical and mental relaxation. This sound, accompanied by the voice of the master, guides us in relaxation to free our minds from all thoughts and release tensions. The rocky vaults amplify the effect of the sounds and vibrations and stimulate the body and mind. A dreamy way to spend an afternoon! Dinner will be on your own this evening at one of four hotel restaurants on the

property.

Wednesday, April 19 - Lucca & Cooking Class

After breakfast, we drive at 10am to Lucca. The historic city is known as one of Italy's "città d'arte" (arts town), thanks to its intact Renaissance-era city wall and its very well preserved historic center. It is considered one of Italy's top ten picture-perfect towns. We will participate in a cooking class in a convert with a well known chef. Amy will conduct a dream workshop at a local artisan café, one of her favorite Trattorias in Lucca.

Thursday, April 20 - Florence & Foodie Tour

After breakfast we drive to Florence, the capitol of Tuscany. You will have free time to explore after we check-in to the Plaza Hotel Lucchesi which is in walking distance to all the attractions. Lunch is on your own while you shop and walk around this ancient city where the Medici banking family dominated through their economic influence for three hundred years, all while supporting Italy's greatest artists along the way. We will meet with a local foodie expert who will take us on a private walking tour as we eat dinner like a local at different stops along our stroll.

Friday, April 21 – Florence & Rooftop Cocktail Party
