THE ANDY COONEY MUSICAL TOUR TO IRELAND —OUTLINE ITINERARY

SAT, OCT 8- UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Depart your hometown and take Delta flight 44 departing at 10:35 pm across the Atlantic.

SUN, OCT 9- DUBLIN ARRIVAL & GALWAY

Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland. At 11:00 am celebrate Mass at the airport church. Following Mass, enjoy a light lunch at the Coachman's Inn before continuing on to Galway. Upon arrival, join a local guide for a gentle walking tour around center of the city. Then check into your hotel for your overnight stay. This evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: SALTHILL HOTEL, GALWAY

MON, OCT 10- CLIFFS OF MOHER & RATHBAUN FARM

Today travel south along the coast of Ireland. Stop at the Cliffs of Moher, a wall of rock that plunges 700 feet to the churning Atlantic Ocean below. Next travel through the Burren Country, a unique region of limestone hills where many rare flowers thrive in the sheltered crevices. Continue to Ardrahan to visit Rathbaun Farm, a picturesque 150-year old farmhouse where you can see a variety of animals. The owners will tell you about breeding sheep and cattle together with a lot of information on traditional farming practices. See a sheepdog demonstration before enjoying tea and scones with your group. Then return to Galway, where you will have some free time to freshen up before dinner at the hotel restaurants followed by a performance in the hotel bar by Andy Cooney and some of the great local musicians and entertainers.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: SALTHILL HOTEL, GALWAY

TUE, OCT 11- CARROWMORE & DRUMCLIFFE CHURCHYARD

This morning, visit Carrowmore, the largest cemetery of megalithic tombs in Ireland, and the second largest in Europe. Continue through the hills and boggy fields of County Mayo to County Sligo, called "Yeats' Country" as the poet spent time there. Pause to view his grave in Drumcliffe Churchyard before driving to Donegal. Upon arrival, check into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CENTRAL HOTEL, DONEGAL

WED, OCT 12- SLIEVE LEAGUE CLIFFS

After breakfast enjoy sightseeing around County Donegal, which is renowned for woolen production and tweeds. Travel west along the shores of Donegal Bay through Killybegs and Shalwy to reach the Slieve League cliffs, where the highest point reaches 1,972 feet making them the highest in Europe. Then enjoy some tea and homemade scones before traveling through Malin Beg to capture wonderful scenic views of steeply sloped mountains plunging into the shimmering Atlantic Ocean. Also see stretches of windswept bogland and golden beaches. Head back to your hotel, where you will have some time to relax before dinner. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CENTRAL HOTEL, DONEGAL

THU, OCT 13- GLENVEAGH NATIONAL PARK & DERRY

Leaving Donegal, drive through countryside of windswept hills where sheep are the only animals that can really thrive in this harsh, though starkly beautiful, landscape. Visit Glenveagh Castle and National Park where high walls and conifers provide shelter for an amazing collection of exotic plants, trees and flowers gathered from all over the world. Also visit the Castle,

a Scottish-style baronial mansion, which contains fine antique-filled rooms. Then experience the glorious natural beauty of the Grand Atlantic Drive, which winds through Downings and Rosapenna. Continue pass pristine golden beaches and deserted rocky headlands en route to Derry. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay. After dinner, enjoy a performance in the Everglades Hotel by Andy Cooney and some of the great local musicians and entertainers.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CITY HOTEL, DERRY

FRI, OCT 14- DERRY SIGHTSEEING & GIANTS CAUSEWAY

This morning enjoy a walking tour of central Derry to see the principal sights. Next continue your drive through Limavady and Coleraine to visit the Giant's Causeway. This impressive area of hexagonal columns was formed more than 60 million years ago by the slow and even cooling and contraction of molten lava. Then travel along the causeway coast and admire the beautiful views. Drive to Belfast and check into your hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

SAT, OCT 15- BELFAST HIGHLIGHTS

Today embark on a guided sightseeing tour of the city. In the Titanic Quarter, visit Titanic Belfast. Embark on a journey through the life of the Titanic, from her conception to her tragic end. Then enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure before dinner. After dinner, enjoy a performance at the hotel bar by Andy Cooney and some of the great local musicians and entertainers.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: EUROPA HOTEL, BELFAST

SUN, OCT 16- DOWNPATRICK & ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL
Depart Belfast and drive south to Downpatrick, where you may celebrate
noon Mass at St. Patrick's Church, which is close to St. Patrick's Center.
After Mass, explore Down Cathedral to learn about the reputed grave site
of Saint Patrick. Next visit the Saint Patrick Centre and learn about
Ireland's Patron Saint and the importance of monastic life in the early
Christian period. From Downpatrick, journey southwest into the lakestudded region of Cavan. Upon arrival check into your hotel and enjoy
some time to settle in. In the evening, enjoy dinner at the hotel restaurant
with your group.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CROVER HOTEL, CAVAN MON, OCT 17- BATTLE OF THE BOYNE CENTRE

After breakfast visit the Cavan County Museum, to learn about the history and culture of Cavan County. Next travel southeast to visit the Battle of the Boyne Centre. Learn about the famous battle between King William III and his father-in-law, King James II, which was fought on July 1, 1690. Return to Cavan in time for dinner at your hotel restaurant followed by a performance in the Function Room by Andy Cooney and some of the great local musicians and entertainers.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CROVER HOTEL, CAVAN

TUE, OCT 18- RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport to check in for your flight Delta 45 departing at 11.50, clear security and claim your VAT refund. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying west across the Atlantic Ocean back to JFK at 2:00 pm local time.
