THE ANDY COONEY MUSICAL TOUR TO IRELAND — OUTLINE ITINERARY

TUE, OCT 3 — UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

WED, OCT 4 — DUBLIN ARRIVAL & KILKENNY

Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Stop and enjoy breakfast at a local restaurant before departing Dublin. Leaving Dublin drive to Kildare, which is in the heart of Ireland's horse country. A visit to the Irish National Stud will show you the history and current trends of horse-breeding in Ireland. Then take a walk around the Japanese Gardens and see the charming St. Fiachra's Garden. Continue on to Kilkenny and check into your hotel. Enjoy some time at leisure before joining your group for dinner. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: HOTEL KILKENNY, KILKENNY

THU, OCT 5 — DUNBRODY & WATERFORD CRYSTAL

This morning travel southeast to the town of New Ross to visit the Dunbrody Emigrant Ship. This is a replica of a sailing vessel built in 1845 to transport emigrants from Ireland to North America. From New Ross, travel southwest to Waterford to visit the House of Waterford Crystal. Following your visit, return to Kilkenny where you may like to relax or sightseeing independently before dinner. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: HOTEL KILKENNY, KILKENNY

FRI, OCT 6 — ROCK OF CASHEL & BLARNEY CASTLE

Head west from Kilkenny and stop at the Rock of Cashel for a guided tour of these majestic church ruins. Continue south and stop in Blarney to climb to the battlements of the castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Also visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of products. Then journey west to Killarney, where you will check in for your overnight stay. Once you settle into your room join your fellow travelers for dinner.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY SAT, OCT 7 — DINGLE PENINSULA & SLEA HEAD

Today discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, once described by the National Geographic Traveler as "the most beautiful place on earth." Drive along the south shore of the peninsula for plenty of vistas of heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach and rocky headlands. There will be frequent stops to admire the views and take photos. Stop in Dingle town for some leisure time before continuing on to Slea Head at the western tip of the peninsula. This excursion will give you excellent views of mountains and coastline and looking over to the Iveragh Peninsula. Return to Killarney in time for dinner followed by Mass and an independently arranged hotel performance. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY

SUN, OCT 8 — CLIFFS OF MOHER & GALWAY

After celebrating Mass this morning, depart Killarney and travel north to Tarbert. Take a ferry ride across the River Shannon estuary and drive along the coastline of County Clare to view the Cliffs of Moher, one of

the country's most magnificent rock formations. Pass through the Burren Country, an area of rocky limestone hills where a number of unique flowers thrive. Drive around Galway Bay before arriving at your hotel in Galway. Enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure to relax or do some exploring on your own before joining your group for dinner. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: SALTHILL HOTEL, GALWAY

MON, OCT 9 — 'QUIET MAN' TOUR & CONNEMARA MARBLE

Today drive north from Galway via Headford to Cong. Discover places featured in the movie on a brief walking tour around this tranquil village and see some of the movie memorabilia in the "Quiet Man" Heritage Cottage. Continue to the town of Moycullen and visit the Connemara Marble Factory. See how the marble is made into many decorative items. Stop at O'Connor's in Salthill and enjoy some live music with your group. Return to your hotel in time for dinner. DINNER & OVERNIGHT: SALTHILL HOTEL, GALWAY

TUE, OCT 10 — CLONMACNOISE

Travel from Galway to the center of Ireland to visit Clonmacnoise. This monastic settlement was founded in 545 ad by St. Ciaran and is delightfully set on the banks of the River Shannon. Continue your journey through farming country of the midlands to Cavan, a region dotted with many lakes. Upon arrival check into your hotel where you will have time to relax. Tonight enjoy dinner with your group at the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: CAVAN CRYSTAL HOTEL, CAVAN WED, OCT 11 — BOYNE VALLEY VISITOR CENTRE

After breakfast, drive out of the lake-studded region of Cavan and through the midlands of Ireland where you can see how many Irish people make their living from agriculture. In County Meath, stop at the Boyne Valley Visitor Centre to learn about the nearby passage tombs of Newgrange and Knowth constructed over 5,000 years ago. After your visit, drive to Dublin and check into your hotel. This evening drive to the town of Rathfarnham to Taylors Three Rock for dinner followed by a lively show of traditional Irish songs, dancing and music. OVERNIGHT: DOUBLETREE BY HILTON BURLINGTON, DUBLIN

THU, OCT 12 — DUBLIN SIGHTSEEING

Set off with a local guide this morning who will show you around the prominent historic buildings and monuments of Dublin. Stop at Trinity College to see the Book of Kells, an 8th century illuminated manuscript of the gospels and see the Old Library. Spend the afternoon shopping or sightseeing independently before joining your group for a farewell dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT: DOUBLETREE BY HILTON BURLINGTON, DUBLIN

FRI, OCT 13 — RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport in good time to check in for your flight. Enjoy your flight back to the United States.
