MONDAY, OCTOBER 5th - COUNTY MUSEUM CAVAN

After breakfast we meet our driver/guides at 9:30am in the hotel lobby. Today, visit **Cavan County Museum** and is housed in the former Convent of St. Clare in Balllyjamesduff. The Museum was established to collect, conserve and display the material heritage

and culture of County Cavan, over its 6000-year history, for the benefit of the people The former convent building comprises the exhibition spaces and gardens. The collections range from prehistoric to modern objects, including the Killycluggin Stone, the Lavey Sheela na gig, costumes in the Pighouse Collection, and GAA paraphernalia. We'll have lunch at Farnham Arms Hotel in Cavan Town where the Percy French Bar pays tribute to the Irish Songwriter, Entertainer, Poet and Painter, is a favorite among Cavan people whether for an informal meeting, a drink after work. Return to your hotel and relax before dinner at the hotel restaurant with the group followed by a performance by Andy Cooney and friends.

TUESDAY OCTOBER 6th – DUBLIN CITY & TAYLORS THREE ROCK

After breakfast head out for an introductory tour of Dublin including O'Connell Street, St. Stephen's Green, the seat of Government at Leinster House, and other buildings. Take a stroll through Trinity College to view the priceless 8th century Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript of the four gospels. WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 7th - FERRY TO HOLYHEAD & LIVERPOOL

- John Lennon's childhood home
- Paul McCartney's childhood home (passengers get off the bus here)
- Former schools and colleges of John, Paul, George and Ringo including the Art College and the Liverpool Institute (now LIPA)

Many more Beatles locations will be pointed out as you travel around the city centre and

suburbs. Liverpool is one of the best cities in the world when it comes to music and we're allowed to say that because it's definitely true!
