SATURDAY 17th MAY – WASHINGTON DULLES TO DUBLIN

Depart **Dulles** on **Aer Lingus flight 118** to **Dublin** at **8.40pm**. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service on your overnight flight.

SUNDAY 18th MAY – ARRIVAL & NEWGRANGE



Arrive at Dublin airport where We will be met by our tour driver/guide. Transfer by private motorcoach to **Belfast** and enjoy a group breakfast on our way. We will visit **Newgrange**, a Stone Age (Neolithic) monument in the Boyne Valley. Located on a rise overlooking the Boyne River, it is a grand passage tomb older than the Great Pyramids of Giza. Check-in to our hotel in Belfast. Meet your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner at the hotel tonight.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT THE GRAND CENTRAL HOTEL (B, D)

MONDAY 19th MAY – TOUR OF BELFAST & THE TITANIC MUESUM

After breakfast, we will visit **Titanic Belfast**, a wonderful attraction where we will embark on a journey through the life of the Titanic. It is located on the former site of Harland & Wolf Shipyard, where the Titanic was built and where it set sail from in 1912. We will take a **guided sightseeing tour** of the city of **Belfast**, an attractive city today that has many remnants of its troubled past. Most notable are the impressive murals which depict the struggles. There is an abundance of pubs and restaurants and plenty of good shopping.

TUESDAY 20th MAY – BUSHMILLS DISTILLERY & GIANT'S CAUSEWAY



We will check out of our Belfast hotel and travel along the **Antrim** coast to **Cushendall** before we arrive in **Bushmills** to visit the famous distillery. In 1608, in **Bushmills**, a legend was born. In that year, King James I granted a very particular license to this small village, just a few miles inland from Northern Ireland's rugged north coast. The license gave Bushmills the right to distil whiskey.

Bushmills is home to the oldest licensed whiskey distillery in the world. Over 400 years later, they're still making whiskey in Bushmills. They're still using Irish barley - and the unique water from their own stream. Afterwards we will walk on the **Giants Causeway**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Giant's Causeway is a magnificent geological formation on the Northeast coast of County Antrim, steeped in myths and legends. Meet your fellow travelers for dinner at the hotel tonight.

WEDNESDAY 21st MAY – WALKING TOUR OF DERRY



After breakfast We will take a **guided walking tour of Derry**, with your guide Charlene McCrossan. Learn about the city's history. As you walk on the historic 400-year-old walls our guide will cover everything from the 6th Century Christian Settlement to the Siege of 1689 and the modern-day troubles. The rest of the day is free to explore Derry or relax and enjoy the hotel's facilities. Dinner at the **Walled City Brewery** tonight.

OVERNIGHT AT EBRINGTON HOTEL (B, D)

THURSDAY 22nd MAY – GLENVEAGH NATIONAL PARK & GWEEDORE

Leaving Derry, we travel to **Glenveagh National Park** that lies in the heart of the **Derryveagh Mountains** in Donegal. The park is 40,000 acres of remote and beautiful wilderness of rugged mountains, deep glens, pristine lakes, and a resident red deer herd. The centerpiece of the park is the 19th century **Glenveagh Castle** with its ornate gardens. The Visitors Center exhibits the history of the park. We'll also see the highest mountain in Donegal, **Mount Errigal** on our way to **Gweedore** in the **Gaeltacht**, the ancestral home of Clannad, Enya and Moya Brennan and onto **Leo's Tavern** for lunch. We will travel through the **Blue Stack Mountains** to **Dunloe** before checking into our hotel in **Donegal Town**. Group Dinner at the hotel tonight.

FRIDAY 23rd MAY – ARDARA & TRIONA DESIGN

Following breakfast, we will drive through the fishing village of **Killybegs** and **Teelin** and travel to **Slieve League Sea Cliffs**, one of Ireland's best-kept secrets and a point of interest along the **Wild Atlantic Way**. Take in the astounding panoramic views of **Slieve League** swooping down from the mountain with a staggering 2000 feet drop into the swirling Atlantic Ocean below with amazing vistas.



This stunning sight is three times higher than the Cliffs of Moher! We will travel through gorgeous **Glencolmille** onto the town of **Ardara** for lunch and a visit to the **Triona Design** where we will see the fine art of hand weaving tweed at the loom woven with the same traditional skills that have been used for centuries. We will then cross the **Glengesh Pass** stopping in **Donegal Town** for a stroll before dinner at the Hotel.

DINNER & OVERNIGHT AT MILL PARK HOTEL (B, L, D)

SATURDAY 24th MAY – SHED DISTILLERY & DUBLIN CITY

After breakfast, we depart Donegal Town, driving south to county **Leitrim** to visit the award-winning **Shed Distillery** – home of Gunpowder Gin, Drumshanbo Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey, and other remarkable creations from the curious mind of PJ Rigney. A fully guided experience including an expert tasting their Single Pot Whiskey and finishing off with a refreshing Gunpowder Gin and tonic at the **Honey Badger Bar** in the majestic botanical glasshouse. We will have lunch here before we continue our way to Dublin where we will spend the last 2 nights. We will check-in to our hotel and have free time to explore the capital city.

SUNDAY 25th MAY – GUINNESS STOREHOUSE & DUBLIN CITY



After breakfast, we will visit the **Guinness Storehouse**. Immerse yourself in 7 floors of fun and excitement as we explore the story of Ireland's most iconic beer. Enjoy the panoramic views from the famous Gravity Bar, dive into the history of Guinness and experience the unique taste of Guinness. After lunch enjoy some free time to explore Dublin. Farewell group dinner at the hotel tonight.
